

GN Qazi- restless & dissatisfied

As a young graduate from Karachi school of Art (1995), Qazi astonished art connoisseurs with his watercolour renditions. He painted dwellings, streets and bazaars of interior Sindh in ochre with delicacy. He painted realities of everyday life. One could see the kite flyers from the interior of a dark room through an open balcony. A scene of wind catchers gave a far view of any cluster of dwellings in the interior of Sindh. He painted sizzling summer noontime when life was clouded by the severity

of sunshine and quiet prevailed on the atmosphere. Qazi's brush lent life and beauty to scenes and time. He used his colours with painterly skills. Blue of a dress was balanced by a dab of the same shade on a ragged wall or a floating wastepaper.

Painting his present time and atmosphere, he kept his eyes on the horizons of the future, which was promising for the young artist. Sun ridden scenarios of Hyderabad and Thatta became a hallmark of the artist. Soon after hepainted scenes from other cities of Pakistan. Within a decade, he became an academy as some new artists



followed his style, subject and palette. Qazi was disturbed by it. He adopted a new approach to handle his space and time. He experimented with acrylics on canvas and painted Basant in Lahore creating an ambiance of evening with tan shades for his exhibition at Croweaters, Lahore. The circumstance was a contrast to his sun ridden canvases in ochre.


Qazi did not settle down here. He was restless and dissatisfied. This gave vent to a new style closely related to his early works on Sindh. He painted mud dwellings in cubistic abstraction. His progression was in the right direction. With light and shade, he created mature resolutions, also unaffecting his signature.

At his studio, while viewing his Basant series, I came across something absolutely different. It was a canvas in bright yellow with two dried up trees and a few birds flying with their wings closed. It was an indicator that something else was cooking up at the unconscious of the artist. At Unicorn, it has become obvious now. Here we see a new face of Qazi. It is almost a uturn. There are a good number of new works with women. The portraits feature lines of Bengal School. He adds florets, head of a horse, birds, moon, dried up branches, urns etc to have a dialogue with space.











These works are like pausing for a friendly coffee party to which Qazi brings flowers in vase as a gesture of goodwill. Qazi has been painting vases with flowers along with his rural situations. He has introduced a new style with cubistic background. The show at Unicorn is a retrospection of 12 years of Qazi's paintings. The viewer gets a chance to see the frustration, restlessness and dissatisfaction a true artist suffers all his life and translates it aesthetically on his canvases. His early work on Sindh is popular among all. His heading towards abstraction on some canvases with jolted buildings signifies maturity he has gained over the years. His women and birds canvases are like a stroll in the garden where Qazi is deciding which patio to step on.


